April 6, 2009

The April meeting of the York Suburban All-Sports Booster Club was called to order by President Bob Perina.

Review of Minutes: It was brought to Bob's attention that there was no motion made to approve the February meeting Treasurer's Report. A motion to approve the March minutes and to approve the February meeting Treasurer's Report was made by Marina Roos, a second by Sue Huth. The motion carried.

President-Elect: Tom Sprigle. No report.

Athletic Director's Report: Larry Ludwig. Larry will have the spring banquet dates tomorrow and will send to Tom to post on the website. Larry mentioned there is a small change to the girls' soccer tournament - York Catholic and Fairfield will not have a JV team so the JV game will be played between the varsity games and the consolation and championship game. The concession stand will not have to run as long so Bob will talk to Kim George about that.

Webmaster: Tom Sprigle. There are up to 9,192 hits on the website, up over 1,000 hits since last month. Bob mentioned what a great idea putting pictures of the spring team posters on the website was. He reminds everybody to click on the image for a larger view.

Event Scheduling Manager: Kim George. Not present.

Upcoming Tournaments: Bob Perina

1. Girls' Soccer Tournament (April 25) - First annual. We are starting out small this year since this is a new fundraiser for us. We will make around \$450 in entry fees, gate and concessions profits and we will sell 60 T-shirts for \$10 each. In addition there will be programs and a trophy for the winning team.
2. York Suburban Relays (May 2) - 50th anniversary. Sponsorships are trending down so far, which is not unexpected. Tom suggested Lynn send him sponsorship forms, or any other information for the website. Bob will relay the message.

Spirit Functions: Bob mentioned how well Meet the Teams Night went.

Scholarship: Jenny Foster. April 17th is the spring application deadline.

New Business:

1. Outdoor Concession Stand - What started out as good intentions of getting the volunteers food safety certified, ended up with the state mandating our stand to be licensed and brought up to code. To meet code, we will need new sinks, stainless countertops, and numerous other fixes. Dr. Orban and food service has told us we will be limited in what we can sell. This will severely curtail our profits. Barry Girling has offered his allocated money for his use to outfit the stand with the correct sinks and stainless countertops. He will try to get this done by the YS Relays on May 2nd but that is a tall order. A big thank you to Barry. Marina Roos suggested selling bagels with prepackaged cream cheese. Maybe we could even get the bagels donated.
2. Position openings for 2009/2010 - We are still in need of a President-Elect. It is helpful to have one in place by August as this person can learn the job of president over the course of a full school year.
3. Team Reps for 2009/2010 - Team reps for this year, please let Bob know if you intend to keep your position for the next school year, if not, if you could recommend someone that might be interested.

Old Business:

1. Macadam Pathway - The equipment is on the high school grounds and weather is the only deterrent at this point. Bob thinks that it could happen by the end of this week. He is hoping to have a metal plate placed on the fence above the walkway stating that the Booster Club is responsible for the path.
2. Principal's Fund - This fund helps a student that cannot afford basic necessities for a particular sport. It is brought to the attention of the principal;

he/she signs off on it and sends it on to the Booster Club for payment. This is not a common situation.

Karen Simon wanted to make sure that the donation in honor of Donna Platt's retirement be made to Tennis for Kids. She will send Sue the pertinent information.

Bob will take care of that.
