

York Suburban All-Sports Booster Club Meeting Minutes September 19, 2011

The September meeting of the York Suburban All-Sports Booster Club was called to order by President Missy Badovinac at 7:10pm.

In attendance: Missy Badovinac, Peggy Davidson, Kim George, Celeste Hinnenkamp, Carol Kauffman, Kim Adams, Rebekah Sweeney, Lori Markel, Ron Simmers, Bob Perina, Troy Patterson, Greta Kottmyer

Minutes from the June 2011 meeting as read aloud were accepted upon motion by Ron Simmers and second by Kim George.

Treasurer, Ron Simmers distributed a 2010-11 Financial Statement. He stated that annual team allocations left over from last year have been carried over. A question was asked by Kim Adams about reimbursements for field hockey; this led to discussion about how expenditures must be approved and that the A.D. has final say about what can or cannot be paid.

Missy Badovinac reported for Assistant Treasurer, Scott Strickler that they have developed a cash receipts form for Concessions. The money is to be picked up by the A.D., Assistant A.D. or Missy or Lori Markel should be called by the volunteers if they are not available

Athletic Director – not present.

Awards & Flowers -- Susan Huth sent a written report that she has been researching prices. She will get info to the teams about the number of awards that can be given out.

Banquets – Susan sent a recommendation that the banquets held in the cafeteria can be made nicer, a little more elegant by using warming trays, serving pieces. She recommended purchase of items for Booster Club to own. Upon motion of Missy Badovinac and second by Ron Simmers, the club approved a spending allowance of up to \$500 for these items. Motion carried. Rebekah Sweeney offered that she may have items to donate or lend for this purpose, thereby reducing the expenditure.

Membership – Rebekah Sweeney reported that there are 136 current members of Booster Club (representing 163 athletes) for \$5,100 in membership receipts. Ron reminded that some families have multiple students so the numbers won't equal. Once Rebekah receives the rosters, she will be able to provide info on the participation for each team. The club was enthusiastic about the receipts so far.

Directory – Great Kottmyer reported that she is currently working on it

Spirit Wear – Bob Perina left right before this came up on the agenda. Missy restated that she would like Booster Club to have a sale of left-over items in inventory.

Boys Soccer – netted \$931 from their tournament and over \$1,000 from concessions.

Volleyball tournament results were unknown at the time of the meeting.

Boys Basketball Tournament – Celeste Hinnenkamp reported about the new level of super sponsors which combines a program ad with event sponsorship for a small increase.

Fall Program – ad sales grossed \$3,100. A copy was passed around and received lots of raves from all present. Missy reported that in order to reduce cost, she had to cut extraneous pages and the

program is all about the students and the advertisers.. This year, the cost covered more programs for less money.

Missy reported on a check received in memory of former principal Stan Houser. She sent a nice thank you letter to the donor and copied the daughter of Mr. Houser. This resulted in a lovely letter from his daughter and a significant check (\$1,000) to the Booster Club. Discussion ensued on how best to use these funds. It was agreed not to put into general operating fund but come up with a special use.

Current Year Officers and Committee Chairs – Upon motion by Ron Simmers and second by Kim George, the current year officers and committee chairs were ratified.

Outdoor Concessions – Missy stated that we need to address replacing the concession stand manager who has agreed to stay on another year. We are looking for volunteers who would be willing to take it over. It was suggested to post it on the web site.

Discussion ensued on Market Street Sports, a Lancaster firm awarded a concert by the YS School District to promote sponsorship around the school district. Not much info was known and Missy will request A.D. Peterson to speak about it at the next Booster Club meeting.

Fundraising – Troy Patterson reported on fundraising cards which would be developed and sold. Troy offered to design and make the arrangements, but a team of volunteers to sell ads for the card is necessary. Missy requested Ron develop a contract form for vendors and that Troy come up with an info sheet/form to be used in an approach to vendors.

The idea of producing and selling a school calendar was briefly discussed.

It was recommended that Booster Club have a table at Back to School Night to promote.

Missy concluded the meeting by stressing that there are going to be a lot of changes this year and votes will take place here at the meetings by those present. Missy encourages all team reps to ATTEND AND BE YOUR TEAM'S VOICE!

The next Booster Club meeting is scheduled for Monday, October 3 at 7:00pm.

Meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm on motion of Peggy Davidson and second by Kim George.
