

York Suburban All-Sports Booster Club Meeting Minutes May 2, 2011

The May meeting of the York Suburban All-Sports Booster Club was called to order by President Tom Sprigle at 7:05pm.

Minutes from the April 2011 meeting were accepted upon motion by Kim George and second by Sally Massey.

Mr. Petersen reported the following items then had to leave for a district meeting at 7:15pm:

- Junior high sports are untouched for 2011-12, per a decision by the superintendents
- Team posters – will now be donated by Lifetouch in the form of an 11x17 framed poster displayed in the halls
- June sports physicals will no longer be paid by YS. The cost is \$15
- Beginning in the new school year a one-time activity fee of \$25 will be charged for any student participating in any sports and/or extracurricular activities. He explained the money goes into the general fund to offset costs.

Well after Mr. Petersen left, discussion ensued on replacing the team posters with framed photos and Missy was requested to have further discussion with him.

President-Elect Missy Badovinac: spoke briefly about researching changes to the fall sports program, to implement changes, save money and increase revenue.

Treasurer's Report: Ron Simmers reported:

- Current cash is \$28,900 approximately \$18,000 behind last FY
- Wrestling tournament lost \$700 - the only tournament losing money this year
- Certificates of deposit (approx \$18,000) will be moved to Metro Bank
- Reiterated that all receipts and payables must be submitted to President for approval. Do not give items directly to Ron.
- Money remaining in team allocations must be spent by June 15 or it goes back to the Booster Club

Assistant Treasurer, Scott Strickler – not present

Awards & Flowers, Kim Jones -- not present, no report.

Sarah Perina: Not present.

Fundraising: General discussion that this position will be important in the upcoming year.

Scholarship, Susan Huth announced six winners for spring sports. Awards were passed to Missy Badovinac who will make the check presentations on behalf of Booster Club.

Directory– not present, no report

Nominating – not present, no report

Outdoor Concession Stand – Tom Sprigle stated that the role will be changing for this position next year and BC expects more of a reporting role on the OCDS. A manager is needed. Tom reminded that YS gets 10% commission on concessions.

Spirit – not present, no report

Team Allocations, Kim George – No report

Herb Schmidt Relays – Jenny Foster reported that sponsorship of \$2,950 has exceeded last year's total. Programs will be sold for \$2 as opposed to \$1 last year but programs will contain a chance to win a (donated) gift. T-shirts are for sale at \$10 and \$15. The committee is still trying to obtain sponsors for a few more of the T&F events and any more gifts for program winners.

Webmaster, Tom Sprigle –asked for pictures of any of the sports for the web site.

New Business:

Girls Soccer Tournament – went well, sold all but 4 t-shirts. To improve sales in future years, they recommended taking pre-orders.

(Spring Banquet vote – this was an error on the agenda, left over from prior month)

Old Business:

Booster Club Nominations for 2011-12 and 2012-13. Upon motion by Missy Badovinac and second by Ron Simmers, this topic was tabled for June meeting.

New Business:

Meeting adjourned at 8:38pm on motion of Ron Simmers and second by Missy Badovinac.

Forming committees to work over the summer was briefly discussed and will be continued at the June meeting.
